The Cinco Bayou Town Council and the town staff have been busy this summer planning for some much needed capital improvements to our town. While grant requirements, federal/state regulations, and other forms of red tape have delayed some projects, we are finally looking at completing some repairs and providing some enhancements within the town limits.

The fishing pier at Winn Davis Park is nearing a start date. Grant requirements have held up the construction of this project for several months. FEMA dollars will allow the repair of a section of Yacht Club Drive damaged in last spring's flooding. A perpendicular extension (paid for with grant dollars from the State of Florida) will be added to the boat launch at Sea Way in order to address some traffic issues at that popular spot. Kelly Avenue will be repaved in late October/early November (if all goes as planned). And our new CEFCO Station will be opening in a matter of days.

As we anticipate the arrival of cooler weather and the holiday season, we are so fortunate to live and work in this unique neighborhood here on Florida's incredible Emerald Coast. Please show your appreciation of all the blessings we enjoy as citizens of this great nation by participating in the upcoming election.
